2000 Spring Enrollment Highlights

One Year Comparison: Spring 1999 to Spring 2000

There was an overall increase in headcount of more than two percent with a corresponding 2% increase in FTEs.

In hard numbers, there was an increase in headcount of 747 students (from 31,331 last spring to 32,078 this spring).

FTEs increased from 26,365 last spring to 26,794 this spring resulting in 429 more FTEs.

Five Year Comparison: Spring 1996 to Spring 2000

From five years ago, the number of students in the System has decreased 1.2%. That is, the NDUS has 404 fewer students in Spring 2000 than in Spring 1996.

FTEs have also decreased within the same time frame. In 1996, the System had 27,238 FTEs. This Spring, the System has 26,794 FTEs which is a decrease of 1.6% from five years ago.

Ten Year Historical Chart: Spring 1991 to Spring 2000

This Spring's headcount (32,078) is slightly higher than the 10-year average of 31,921.

The 10-year average for Spring FTEs is 26,845. This Spring's FTEs are 51 FTEs above the average.

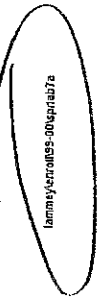

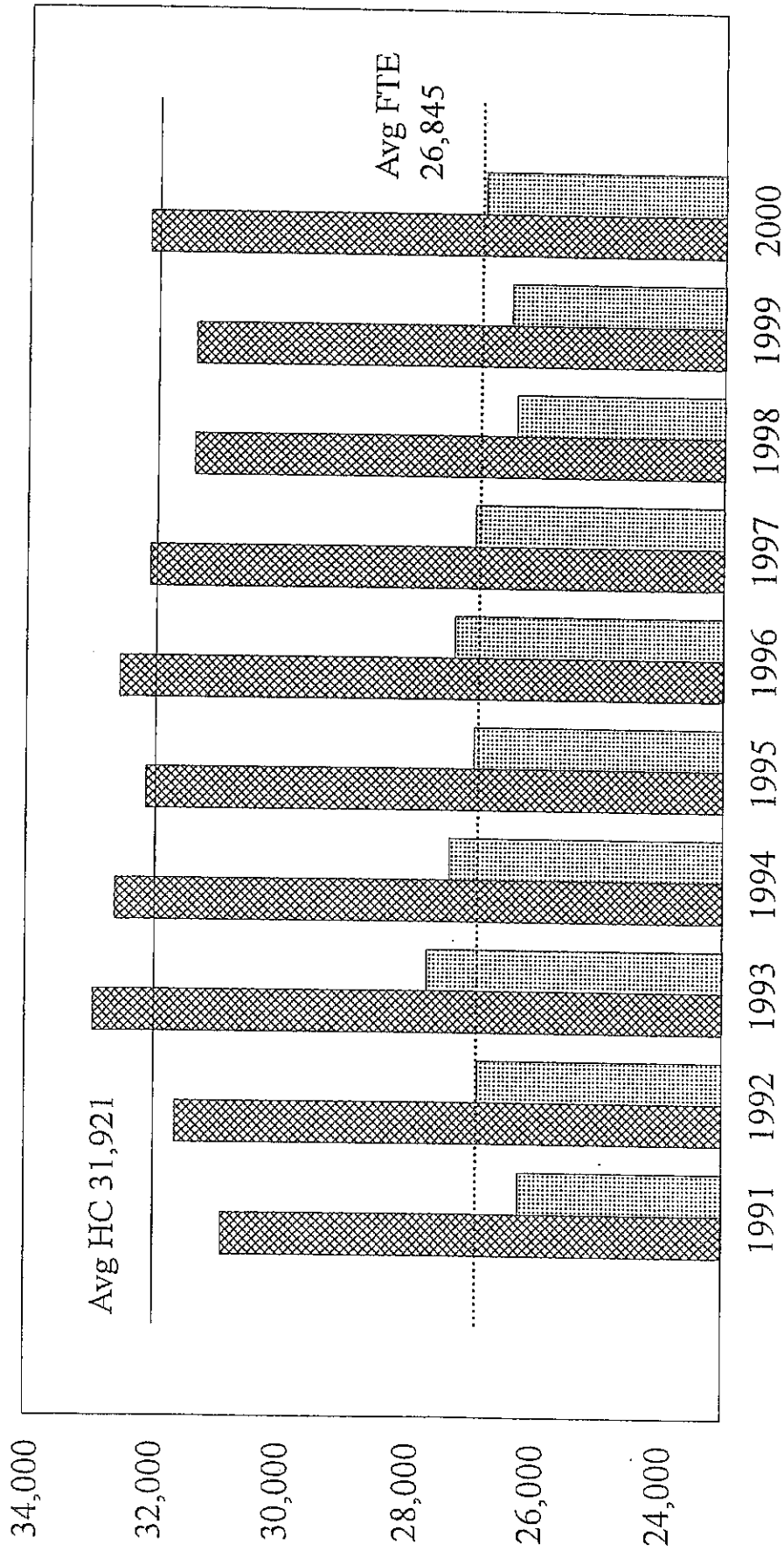
