Report Summary

The North Dakota University System Annual Enrollment Report is an attempt to report a single system wide, unduplicated count by combining degree credit, non-degree credit, and non-credit enrollments for an entire academic year. The academic year being reported is Summer 2013, Fall 2013 and Spring 2014 semesters.

The three credit types reported can be defined as follows:

Degree Credit - all coursework and instructional activities that carry credit that can be applied toward college degree, or credit based remedial courses taken by a degree seeking student as reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS).

Non-Degree Credit – all coursework that carries college credit, but does not count toward a college degree; this includes continuing education coursework.

Non-Credit – coursework that does not carry academic credit; noncredit courses do not count toward college degree.

In addition to credit types, this report also breaks down course enrollments by delivery method. Those methods include both on campus and distance education delivery. Face-to-Face on campus courses are those that take place in the traditional classroom environment where instructor and students are located in the same place on campus. Distance Education (DE) coursework are those in which students are not located in a traditional face to face classroom on their home institution. DE includes correspondence, synchronous and asynchronous internet, one way video, and two way (IVN) courses. Combination (combo) classes are distance education courses that utilize a mix of delivery methods, with less than 50% coming from any one delivery type.

The Summary Table on page 4 provides the summative data for annual enrollment. Campus Solutions reporting has allowed identification of 63,591 unduplicated student enrollments across the eleven system institutions. Additionally, there were 22,690 non-credit registrations where insufficient information was provided to determine whether students were duplicated or unduplicated. Therefore the actual unduplicated headcount for NDUS annual enrollment lies within the range of 63,591 to 86,281.

Table sets 1, 2, and 3 report for degree credit, non-degree credit, and non-credit headcount respectively. Unlike the other tables, Table 4 provides information on non-credit registrations. Since most non-credit activities operate on the self-supporting basis of adequate registrations, information on registrations rather than enrollments has been provided by the NDUS institutions. Since Table 4 includes only registration numbers, this data has not been incorporated into any other report tables.
