**North Dakota University System
Enrollment Highlights
Spring 2018**

One-Year Comparison

Two-Year Institutions:

- Overall Spring 2018 Headcount, Full Time students, and Full Time Equivalencies (FTEs) are comparable to those of Spring 2017 term, with insignificant decreases in all categories of 1.5% or less.
- Increases in Headcount, Full Time students, and FTEs are observed at Dakota College at Bottineau and Lake Region State College. Headcount increased by 93 students (11.8%) over last spring at Dakota College, and by 81 students (4.6%) at Lake Region.
- Bismarck State College exhibited a decrease in headcount (-2.1%), and North Dakota State College of Science (-0.8%) and Williston State College (-0.3%) remained stable.

Four-Year Institutions:

- For regional universities, overall Headcount, Full Time students, and Full Time Equivalencies (FTEs) are comparable to those of Spring 2017 term, with increases at Mayville State University (3.7%) and Valley City State University (6.6%), a decrease at Minot State University (-2.1%), and no change at Dickinson State University (0.0%).
- Research universities showed a decrease in overall Headcount, Full Time students, and Full Time Equivalencies, however, this decrease was less than 2% across each category.

System Wide:

- Across the eleven NDUS institutions, Headcount, Full Time students, and FTEs have remained steady with overall changes amounting to less than 1.1%, which is statistically insignificant.

Five-Year Trend

- Over the past five years, Headcount and FTE in NDUS has decreased slightly, with change in headcount of -2.4%, and in FTE of -2.5%.
- Full Time student headcount has decreased by 4%, or by 1,214 students.

Ten-Year Trend

- The ten-year NDUS headcount has increased 7.6%, from 40,958 to 44,005. The system currently has 1,275 students less than the highest observed student headcount in Spring 2012 (N=45,280) and 4,037 students more than the lowest observed student headcount in Spring 2008 (N=39,968). Over the same ten year period, FTEs have increased by 993 or 2.8%

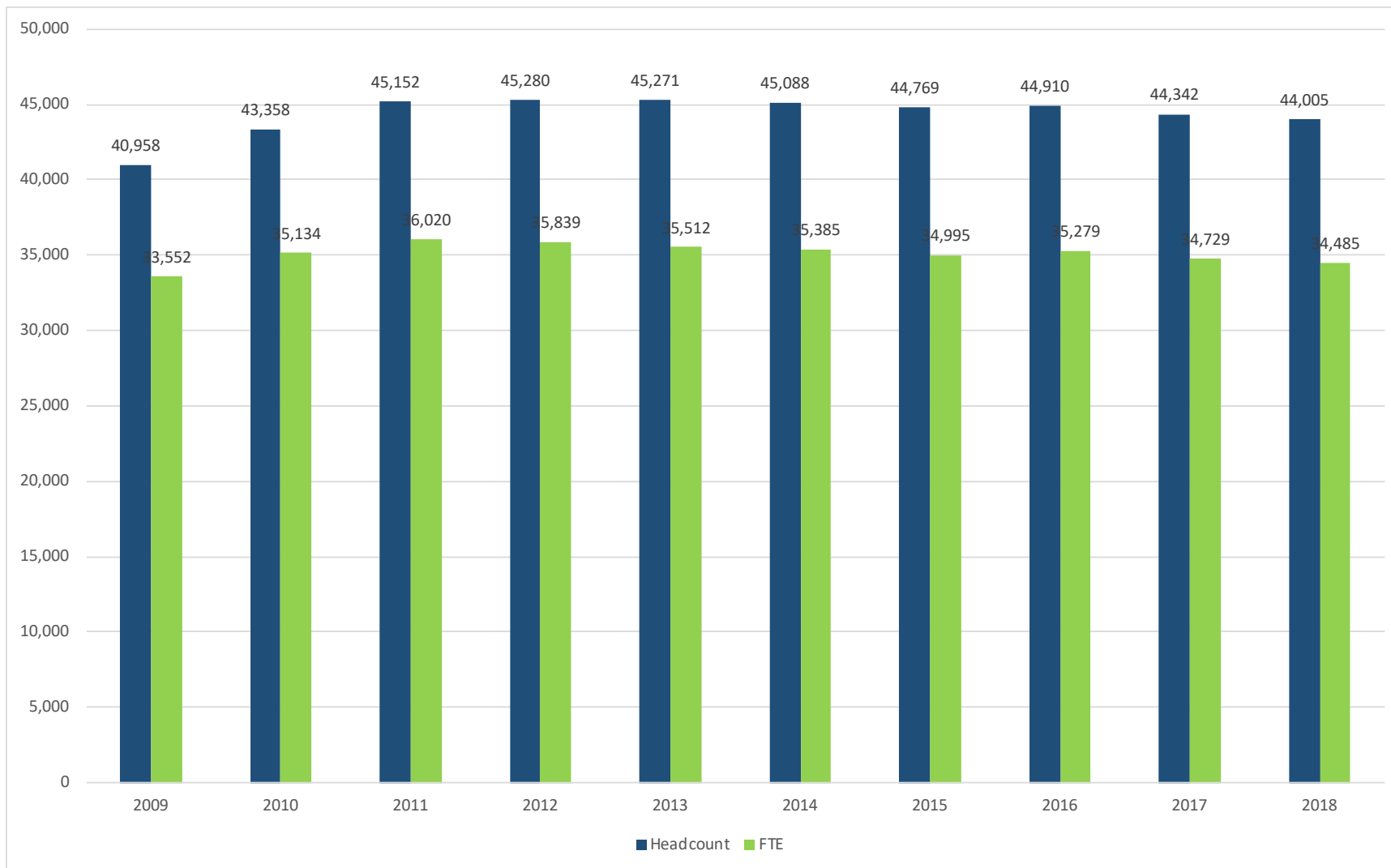
Data Definitions:

HC (Headcount) – A student is counted as one enrollment in courses as of the 20th day of term.

FT (Full Time) – Headcount of undergraduate students enrolled in a minimum of 12 credit hours; graduate and professional students enrolled in a minimum of 9 credit hours.

FTE (Full Time Equivalencies) – On a semester basis means undergraduate total credits hours divided by 15; graduate credit hours divided by 12; every professional student is counted as 1 FTE.

Chart 2: NDUS Full & Part Time Headcount Spring 2018

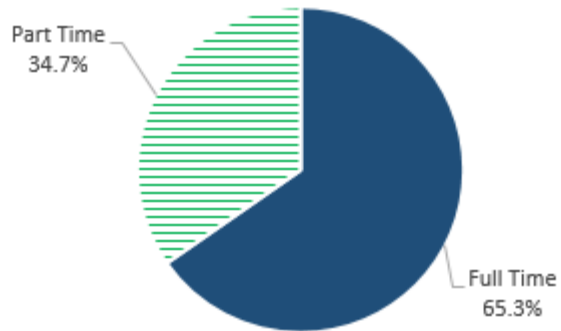


Chart 3: NDUS Headcount by Age Spring 2018

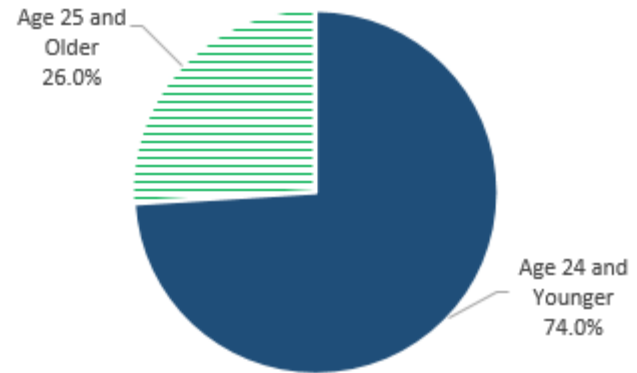


Chart 4: Home State Headcount Spring 2018

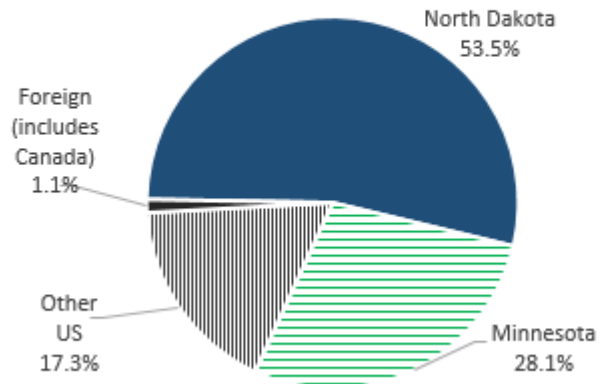
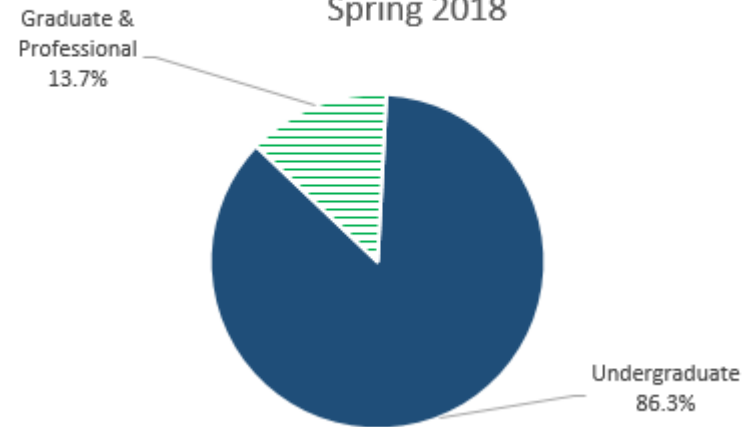


Chart 5: Undergraduate and Graduate/Professional Headcount Spring 2018
