Blackboard Learning Management System
This is the system wide deployment of the Blackboard LMS.

The overall status is Green. The project is under budget (2.9%) and is running behind schedule (12.7%). The performance issues with Blackboard early in the quarter were resolved by the end of January. Due to performance concerns, it was decided to extend the project by about one year. DCB will still go live with all courses starting the 2018 Summer term. DSU will continue piloting courses over Summer term and will have all courses live in the Fall term. MaSU will pilot certain courses over the Summer term and add additional courses for Fall term. MiSU will go live on the Spring 2019 term and NDSU is currently scheduled to go live in the Summer 2019 term. Additional changes are under consideration.
