Large Project Summary Report

UND - AssetWorks

UND is deploying a new facilities management software to replace the current FAMIS software.

The overall status is being reported as Green. The project is behind schedule (2.5%) on the latest revised baseline and under budget (7.2%) to the revised budget baseline. During Q4 2023 the project team continued working to implement ReADY Space and Capital Planning and Project Management (CPPM). The current schedule estimate is the completion of implementation by late January. Post implementation activities will follow.

TargetX

This is a project to implement a new online admission application and customer relationship management (CRM) system, TargetX, throughout nine NDUS institutions (UND and NDSU already use this product.)

The overall status is being reported as Green. The project on schedule (0.0%) on the revised baseline and under budget (0.6%) to the revised budget baseline. Two campuses chose to not deploy the portals portion of the project so were descoped using change procedures. This phase is currently scheduled to complete in mid Q1 and closeout should be completed by the end of Q1.

NDSU-NDSCS Zoom Voice

This initiative replaces NDSU's legacy Avaya voice system with Zoom Phone cloud services. The end product will move voice-related services to the cloud while integrating some on-premises life safety functions on campus.

This project entered into Execution in late Q4. The overall status is being reported as Green. The project is behind schedule (8.3%) and over budget (5.9%). Engineering and configuration of the main cloud environment was completed and the first phase of pilot departments were successfully migrated. The Startup Report is attached.
